CY school of design, within CY Tech, trains global designers for all transitions, from matter to decision, capable of meeting the challenges of the 21st century and occupying positions of responsibility in human organizations.

The person recruited will integrate and teach in "CY school of design" within the CY Tech engineering school, part of CY Cergy Paris Université (CYU). She/he will be involved in the Global Designer (5 years) and Digital Engineer-Designer (6 years) dual degree programs. The candidate will supervise and participate in the human and social sciences curriculum, including methods and disciplines of inquiry for design. His/her teaching will also include an introduction to design research and interdisciplinary work and collaboration between designers and engineers. The teacher-researcher is expected to participate in the development of new teaching methods or modalities through design within CY Tech Graduate School and more generally for the benefit of the university components and CY Alliance.

Research Profile

Detailed research profile

The ETIS laboratory (CNRS UMR8051) conducts multi-disciplinary, theoretical and experimental research into the modeling of technical devices and social interactions, and into new technologies as specific environments. The "Design Research" research team set up in 2021 will support the research on these issues through the prism of SHS and design sciences. The team's objective is to analyze emerging design practices studied from the angle of mediations between human and non-human actors that support the infrastructures needed for ecological transition.

Research in information and communication sciences is thus fundamental to identifying systemic social and political issues and the dynamics of designing new mediation and situations. The team's positioning on the issue of sustainability implies analyzing new modalities of design, mediation and circulation of knowledge and methods. The laboratory wishes to develop novel observation methodologies that not only involve all stakeholders, but also include many unknowns, given that systems are not fully defined. The candidate is expected to have knowledge of these issues, as well as action research experience enabling him/her to set up experiments with stakeholders.

The person recruited is also expected to contribute to the development of international research in information and communication sciences and design, within CY école de design and attached to the Graduate School CY Tech. His/her work, skills and previous experience should enable him/her to propose and develop research projects and funding at the interface between information and communication sciences and design, to integrate into a team of teacher-researchers, but also to develop and lead relationships with various partners within or outside CY Cergy Paris Université: universities, public and/or private laboratories, private groups, nationally and internationally.

The person recruited will participate in the development of disciplinary and cross-disciplinary doctoral training in design within the CY Cergy Paris Université (CYU) doctoral and post-doctoral college.

The candidate will possess nationally and internationally recognized skills in the field of research in information and communication sciences and design. He/she is expected to enjoy teamwork and be able to lead collaborative research projects.
